

TWO-HOUSE VOTED UPON BILLS (1-13)

1. **S7694A Gounardes, A8148A Rozic**- Prohibits addictive social media platforms.
Party Position: Support
2. **S08058 Hoylman-Sigal, A8627 Bronson**- Creates protections for gender care and transition regardless of age within the NYS legal system.
Party Position: Opposed
3. **S8638 Myrie, A00435 Magnarelli**- Restricts where you can bring challenges to reapportionment to counties that have heavy Democratic partisan courts.
Party Position: Opposed
4. **S1003 A Hinchey, A733 Rozic**- Government effort to impose state public policy on not-for-profit hospitals.
Party Position: Opposed
5. **S00206 Cleare, A1432 Aubry**- Removes lifetime ban on jury duty for convicted felons.
Party Position: Opposed
6. **A8803, S8303D (Budget)**- Includes \$26 million to expand capacity and ensure access to abortions.

7. **A8807C, S8307C (Budget)**- Includes new healthcare related taxes that will be passed down, raising the cost of healthcare.

8. **A8809 B, S8309 B (Budget)**- Renewal of taxes and fees and creation of new taxes and fees.

9. **Elfa A8806, S8306 (Budget)**- Good cause evictions: Roll back of tier 6 salary average to tier 5 average at great cost to state and local governments.

10. **S2129 Krueger, A3351 Dinowitz**- Climate change superfund.

11. **S2812 Gounardes, A5259A Septimo**- NYC red light camera renewal and expansion.

- S14. **S09276 Gianaris**- Allows evidence of a defendant's prior sexual offenses to be admissible in the sexual assault proceedings.

- S15. **S348C Cleare**- Enacts reproductive freedom and equality grant program to ensure access to abortion care.
Party Position: Opposed
- S16. **S7506 Hoylman-Sigal**- Government action in support of gender transition for minors over the objection of parents.
Party Position: Oppose
- S17. **S2237 Rivera**- Provides illegal immigrants with expanded state benefits.
Party Position: Opposed
- S18. **S9137 Gianaris**- Prohibits openly carrying a shotgun or rifle.
Party Position: Opposed
- S19. **S2016 Cleare**- NY Heat Act to limit the use of natural gas.
Party Position: Opposed
- S20. **S4246 Harckham**- Plastic Reduction Act which puts expensive new recycling requirements on businesses.

ASSEMBLY ONLY (A14-A20)

- A14. **A856 Dinowitz**- Prohibits employees from requiring any wavier claims.

- A15. **A4750 Epstein**- Prohibits bounce payment charge fees.

- A16. **A8333 Bores**- Safer Weapons Safer Homes Act which places unreasonable restrictions on the use of firearms to protect family and property.

- A17. **A252 Magnarelli**- Requires campaign material to contain or be made from recyclable material.

- A18. **A4256 Zebrowski**- Regulating drones.

- A19. **A373 Bronson**- Expansion of prevailing wage law to offsite prefabricated items.

- A20. **A2729 Otis**- Requires landlords to mitigate damage when commercial tenants vacate premises in violation of the lease.
